1. READ THE WARNING THAT APPEARS AT THE TOP OF EACH PAGE OF THE PETITION.

2. PRINT CLEARLY IN BLACK OR BLUE INK.

3. PROVIDE ALL REQUIRED INFORMATION.

4. COMPLETE ALL PORTIONS OF THE SIGNATURE LINE.

RULES FOR PETITION CIRCULATORS

1. Each petition circulator shall be at least eighteen years of age and registered with the secretary of state.
2. Signatures collected by any circulator who has not registered with the secretary of state on or before the deadline for filing petitions with the secretary of state shall not be counted.
3. Leave Page Number in upper right corner blank (for office use only)
4. **Any registered voter of the state of Missouri may sign initiative and referendum petitions.**
5. Each page of an initiative or referendum petition shall contain signatures of voters from only one county.
6. Signatures of voters from counties other than the one designated by the circulator in the upper right-hand corner on a given page shall not be counted as valid.
7. **You must personally witness each signature collected.** It is not sufficient that you are merely present in the same room or vicinity. This also means there may only be one circulator per petition.
8. Any person who signs any name other than his or her own to any petition, or who knowingly signs his or her name more than once for the same measure for the same election, or who knows he or she is not at the time of signing the petition a Missouri registered voter shall be guilty of a class A misdemeanor.
9. Any person who knowingly accepts or offers money or anything of value to another person in exchange for a signature on a petition is guilty of a class A misdemeanor.
10. **After a petition section has been circulated, and you are finished gathering signatures, you will need to complete and sign the circulator affidavit of the petition before a notary public commissioned in Missouri.**
11. When you are finished gathering signatures, and have properly completed the circulator affidavit before a notary public, you should then immediately return the petition to the Personhood Missouri address: **Personhood Missouri
